Mr. Wilbur introduced Local Law No. 1 for the year 1960 as follows:

**LOCAL LAW NUMBER ONE, 1960 COUNTY OF
LIVINGSTON, NEW YORK
A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES
FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the Children's Court Judge shall be increased by \$500.00.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the time service increment of the County Attorney shall be increased by \$25.00.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the time service increment of the Commissioner of Public Welfare shall be increased by \$150.00.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect on January 1st, 1961.
