Mr. John C. Wood introduced Local Law No. 1 for the year 1957 as follows:

**LOCAL LAW NUMBER ONE, 1957
COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, NEW YORK
A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES FOR
CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the cost of living adjustment of the Children's Court Judge shall be increased by \$50.00.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the cost of living adjustment of the two Commissioners of Elections shall be increased by \$50.00 each.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the cost of living adjustment of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$100.00.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect on January 1st, 1958.
