

LOCAL LAW NO. 1, 1961, COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON
A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY
OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the Children's Court Judge shall be increased by \$50.00 and the time service increment shall be increased by \$75.00.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the County Treasurer shall be increased by \$100.00 and the time service increment shall be increased by \$150.00.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$700.00 and the time service increment shall be increased by \$100.00.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect on January 1, 1962.
