**A LOCAL LAW, COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES
FOR ELECTION COMMISSIONERS**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY
OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salaries of the two (2) Elections Commissioners shall be increased by \$900.00 with the provision that said increases shall be pro-rated over the last six (6) months of the year 1966 only.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect July 1, 1966.
