

# ADJOURNED MEETING

MONDAY, OCTOBER 24, 1966  
10:00 A. M.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment.

The roll was called showing all members present except Messrs. DeLeeuw, Dunkley, Roeser, Beach and Gibson.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The Chairman announced that the Tentative Budget for 1967 was filed with the Clerk on October 17, 1966 and was turned over to the Finance Committee for their consideration and recommendations on the same date.

The Chairman of the Finance Committee presented the Tentative Budget for Year 1967 as presented by the Budget Officer.

Review of the Tentative Budget followed.

Mr. Gibson is seated

The Chairman declared a recess.

## Afternoon Session

The Board re-assembled.

Messrs. DeLeeuw, Beach and Roeser are seated.

Review of the Tentative Budget continued.

Mr. Roeser presented Local Law No. 2 for 1966 as follows:

### A LOCAL LAW, COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the County Attorney shall be increased by \$500.00.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the two (2) Commissioners of Elections shall be increased by \$200.00 each.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the Commissioner of Public Welfare shall be increased by \$400.00.

Section 4. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$1,517.00 and the time service increment shall be increased by \$150.00.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 1967.
