Privileges of the floor were extended to Messrs. Edward Wilmot, Hugh Smith and Reginald Gross representing The Valley Committee on the Portageville Dam proposition which is to be discussed at a Public Hearing conducted by the Army Corps of Engineers in Mt. Morris on October 25, 1967.

Mr. Roeser presented Local Law No. 1 for 1967 as follows:

A LOCAL LAW, COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual increment of the County Treasurer shall be increased by \$200.00.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the Budget Officer shall be increased by \$200.00.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the two (2) Commissioners of Elections shall be increased by \$200.00 each.

Section 4. Effective as hereinafter provided, the minimum and maximum salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$200.00.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 1968.
