LOCAL LAW NO. 1, 1971, COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES
FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF
LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the Chairmen of the Board of Supervisors shall be increased by \$1,100.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
for each Supervisor shall be increased by \$550.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall be increased by \$1,627.

Section 4. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the County Judge and Surrogate and Family Court Judge shall be increased
by \$2,000.

Section 5. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the County Treasurer shall be increased by \$1,892.

Section 6. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the County Attorney shall be increased by \$3,265.

Section 7. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the two (2) Commissioners of Elections shall be increased by \$543. each.


Section 8. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased by \$1,417.

Section 9. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary
of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$1,892.

Section 10. All salaries set forth herein shall be retroactive
to January 1, 1971.

Section 11. This Local Law shall take effect on the date of
filing in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
