PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT


BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON  
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph Six of  
Section 215 of the County Law or of any other Law, upon the determination  
by the Board of Supervisors that the residences situate on the lands  
of the former Mt. Morris TB Hospital, Mt. Morris, New York and the  
residence known as No. 6 Court Street, Genesee, New York are not required  
for public use, such property may be leased to individuals and/or  
corporations without bidding or public advertisement for such terms  
and conditions as may be prescribed by the Board of Supervisors.

Section 2. This law is subject to referendum on petition and  
shall not take effect until filed in the office of the Secretary of  
State.
