Section 1. Section 11 of Local Law No. 1 of 1956 of this County entitled "A Local Law to Establish the Livingston County Self-Insurance Plan Under the provisions of Article 5, Workmen's Compensation Law" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. A self-insurance reserve for the plan is hereby established. The maximum amount which shall be contributed to such reserve shall be \$100,000.00. Any interest earned on this reserve shall accumulate, but no more contributions shall be made to said reserve unless said reserve shall fall below the sum of \$30,000.00. If said reserve should at any time fall below said \$30,000.00, such sum as is necessary to bring it to said \$30,000.00 shall be included in the next budget.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect on the date of filing in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

Section 1. Section 11 of Local Law No. 1 of 1956 of this County entitled "A Local Law to Establish the Livingston County Self-Insurance Plan Under the Provisions of Article 5, Workmen's Compensation Law" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. A self-insurance reserve for the plan is hereby established. The maximum amount which shall be contributed to such reserve shall be \$20,000.00 \$100,000.00. ~~The sum of \$5,000.00 shall be included in each annual budget until the full amount of said reserve is reached. If said reserve should at any time fall below the established amount, such sum as is necessary to bring it to the established amount shall be included in the next budget.~~ Any interest earned on this reserve shall accumulate, but no more contributions shall be made to said reserve unless said reserve shall fall below the sum of \$30,000.00. If said reserve should at any time fall below said \$30,000.00, such sum as is necessary to bring it to said \$30,000.00 shall be included in the next budget.
