- Section 1. *Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the two (2) Commissioners of Elections shall be increased by \$650.00 each.*
- Section 2. *Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased by \$3,500.00.*
- Section 3. *Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$2,360.00.*
- Section 4. *Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the Director, Real Property Tax Services shall be increased by \$2,000.00.*
- Section 5. *All salaries set forth herein shall be effective as of January 1, 1982.*
- Section 6. *This Local Law shall take effect on the date of filing in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.*
- Section 7. *This Local Law is subject to permissive referendum.*
