A local law Providing for Publication of Local Laws - Amending Section Two Hundred
Fourteen of the County Law (Insert title)

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the
(Name of Legislative Body)

SECTION 1. Subdivision two of section two hundred fourteen of the County Law as added by chapter six hundred ninety-one of the Laws of nineteen hundred fifty and as further amended by chapter six hundred eighty-five of the Laws of nineteen hundred fifty-one and chapter nine hundred sixty-seven of the Laws of nineteen hundred seventy-three as it applies to the County of Livingston is hereby amended to read as follows:

Local laws and notices. The Board of supervisors shall annually designate at least two newspapers published within the county as official newspapers for the publication of all local laws, notices and other matters required by law to be published. In such designations consideration shall be given to those newspapers advocating the principles of the two major political parties into which the people of the state are divided and their general circulation throughout the county. If there be but one newspaper having circulation in the county, that newspaper shall be designated. Except as otherwise provided by law, the clerk of the board shall cause a notice of adoption of each local law concisely stating the purpose and effect thereof to be published in such official newspapers within ten (10) days after such local law has become effective; provided, however, that if such local law is subject to a permissive referendum such notice shall be published in such official newspapers within ten (10) days after such local law is adopted. Legalizing acts shall be published as provided in section two hundred twenty-seven. Nothing herein shall be deemed to prevent the designation of additional newspapers for any publication and such designation shall be deemed an official newspaper for the particular publication.

SECTION 2. This local law shall take effect immediately; subject, however, to the provisions of section twenty-seven of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
