Local Law No. 3 of the year 1990

A local law transferring preparation of County tax roll duties from Clerk of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors to the Livingston County Director of Real Property Tax Services

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

County
City of Livingston as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to authority found in Section 475 of the County Law of the State of New York, the Livingston County Director of Real Property Tax Services shall prepare the County tax roll for each fiscal year, including extension of the tax rates, and perform such other additional related duties, including but not limited to, the preparation and filing of all pertinent forms or schedules relating to the County Tax Levying process.

SECTION 2. The Livingston County Director of Real Property shall report directly to the Livingston County Board of Supervisors and shall be subject to its supervision, direction and control as set forth herein and in such other resolutions and rules as the Livingston County Board of Supervisors may enact. The Livingston County Director of Real Property shall also perform all duties now or hereafter conferred upon the office by the Livingston County Board of Supervisors, by law, including but not limited to the following:

- a. Appoint such assistants with the office as may be authorized by the Board of Supervisors.
- b. Attend meetings of the Board of Supervisors and its committees and undertake such research and submit to the Board of Supervisors such reports and recommendations as it may, from time to time, request.
- c. Have all the powers necessary and incidental to the performance and exercise of any of the duties and functions lawfully delegated to the office by the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 3. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as modifying, transferring, or abolishing any other power, duty or authority of the Board of Supervisors, any county department or its head or any other elected or appointed official as provided by law.

SECTION 4. This Local Law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
