Section 1:

The Board of Supervisors of Livingston County intends by this Local Law to supersede the portion of County Law §151(3) which authorizes the Board of Supervisors to select a Vice Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors has determined that the Vice Chairman of the Board of Supervisors should be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 2:

The Livingston County Board of Supervisors hereby determines that it is in the best interest of the County of Livingston to supersede the portion of §151(3) of the County Law which authorizes the Board of Supervisors to select a Vice Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The Vice Chairman of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The appointment shall be made within fifteen (15) days of the election of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The term of office of the Vice Chairman shall expire at the end of the calendar year in which he is appointed.

Section 3:

This local law shall become effective when it is filed with the Secretary of State.
