A local law RE-ESTABLISHING THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY TRAFFIC SAFETY BOARD AND

Section 1:

ARTICLE 43 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law authorizes a county to establish a traffic safety board by local law. The Livingston County Board of Supervisors, by Local Law No. 1-1969, established a traffic safety board. The Livingston County Board of Supervisors now desires to reestablish the traffic safety board and establish new membership criteria and meeting guidelines. It is the intent of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors to supercede the provisions of Article 43 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law to the extent they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 2:

The Livingston County Board of Supervisors hereby reestablishes the Livingston County Traffic Safety Board which shall consist of nineteen (19) regular members and nineteen (19) alternate members. One regular member and one alternate member shall be appointed from the Livingston County Highway Department and one regular member and one alternate member shall be appointed from the Livingston County Sheriff's Department. The remaining seventeen (17) regular members and seventeen (17) alternate members shall be appointed as follows: One resident from each town within the County of Livingston shall be appointed as a regular member and one resident from each town within the County of Livingston shall be appointed as an alternate member. The regular and alternate members shall be appointed by the Livingston County Board of Supervisors for three (3) year terms, except for the initial nineteen (19) regular members and nineteen (19) alternate members, who shall be appointed as follows: One-third of each membership class for a term ending December 31, 2000; One-third of each membership class for a term ending December 31, 2001, and One-third of each membership class for a term ending December 31, 2002.

All regular and alternate members must reside within Livingston County. The office of any regular or alternate member who no longer resides within the geographic locality for which they were appointed or who is no longer employed by the department which they represent shall be declared vacant and a successor shall be appointed for the balance of that regular or alternate member's term of office.

Section 3:

The Livingston County Traffic Safety Board shall have its initial annual meeting within forty five (45) days of the effective date of this local law and on or before the 2nd Wednesday of February of each year thereafter. The Livingston County Traffic Safety Board shall elect an Executive Secretary, Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Secretary at the annual meeting. The Executive Secretary shall not be a regular or alternate member of the Livingston County Traffic Safety Board.

Section 4:

Ten (10) voting members of the Livingston County Traffic Safety Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Each regular member shall be entitled to one non weighted vote. Alternate members shall have no vote unless the regular member from their respective town or department is absent from the meeting.

Section 5:

The Chairman of the Livingston County Traffic Safety Board may grant excuses from attendance to regular members. The office of any regular member who has four (4) or more unexcused absences in any twelve month period shall be declared vacant and a successor shall be appointed for the balance of that regular member's term of office. The Chairman of the Livingston County Traffic Safety Board shall notify the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the respective Town Supervisor or Department Head of the name of any regular member who has four (4) or more unexcused absences in any twelve month period.

Section 6:

Local Law No.1-1969 is repealed as of the effective date of this local law.

Section 7:

This Local Law shall be effective upon it's filing with the New York State Secretary of state.


