Section 1. Purpose: The County of Livingston by Local Law No. 1 of the year 2003 adopted the procedures set forth in Article 11 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law for the enforcement of tax liens arising on or after January 1, 2004. The County of Livingston by Local Law No. 5 of the year 2003 extended the redemption period for residential and farm property to three years after the lien date.

The purpose of this local law is to reduce the redemption period for residential and farm property to the standard redemption period of two years after lien date as authorized by Section 1110 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law.

Section 2. Redemption Period: The County of Livingston hereby adopts the redemption period of two years after lien date for residential and farm property for the enforcement of taxes which shall become liens on or after January 1, 2006.

Section 3. Rescission: Local Law No. 5 of the year 2003 is hereby rescinded for the enforcement of taxes which shall become liens on or after January 1, 2006.

Section 4. Filing with State Board: A copy of this local law shall be filed with the New York State Board of Real Property Services within 30 days after its enactment.

Section 5. Effective Date: This local law shall be effective as set forth herein.


