Section 1.

The County of Livingston has the authority to adopt a local law setting forth the powers, duties, mode of selection and removal, and term of office of Deputy Superintendents of Highways provided they are not inconsistent with the Constitution or any general law of the State of New York.

Section 2.

The Livingston County Superintendent of Highways may, with the approval of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors, appoint for a term not extending beyond the term of office of said County Superintendent of Highways, one or more Deputy Superintendents of Highways. The Deputy Superintendents of Highways may be removed at the pleasure of the County Superintendent of Highways.

Section 3.

The Deputy Superintendents of Highways shall have all the powers and duties of the County Superintendent of Highways, and the authority to act generally for and in the place of the County Superintendent of Highways, during the Superintendent=s inability to act, during the Superintendent=s regular or approved vacation periods and at such other times as designated in writing by the County Superintendent of Highways. The County Superintendent of Highways shall designate, in writing, the order in which such deputies shall exercise the powers and duties of the office of County Superintendent of Highways under the provisions of this section. The County Superintendent of Highways shall file such writing in the office of the County Clerk and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 4.

Local Law No. 1999-4 is hereby repealed.

Section 5.

This Local Law shall take affect immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.




