NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW**

**LOCAL LAW NO. 6 - 2015 - SUPERSEDING COUNTY LAW 215 (3) RELATING TO
A LEASE OF REAL PROPERTY FROM LYNN BUTTON AND FRANCES L. BUTTON**

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Livingston as follows:

Section 1:

The Board of Supervisors of Livingston County intends by this Local Law to supersede the provisions of County Law §215 (3) which limits leases of real property by the County to 5 year terms. The Board of Supervisors has determined that the lease of real property on Scipio Road, Nunda, New York from Lynn Button and Frances L. Button for the siting of an emergency communication tower should not be limited to a 5-year term.

Section 2:

The Livingston County Board of Supervisors hereby determines that it is in the best interest of the County of Livingston to supersede the provisions of §215 (3) of the County Law and therefore authorizes the lease of real property on Scipio Road, Nunda, New York from Lynn Button and Frances L. Button for the siting of an emergency communication tower for a period of 99 years. The terms of such lease shall nevertheless be subject to the prior approval of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors.

Section 3:

This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum.

Section 4:

This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.


