

To the Hon., the House of Representatives,
and Senate of the United States:

We, the undersigned, citizens of Mount Morris, in the County of Livingston in the State of New York, believing that SLAVERY as it exists in America, is a hainous sin against God, and a flagrant violation of the rights of man, inconsistent with Christianity, with our national Declaration of Independence, and with our Republican Institutions, impeding the march of liberal principles abroad; and detrimental to the interests and subversive of the liberties of the laboring population of our republic, at home; a reproach to us in the eyes of the world, and a national crime, exposing us to the judgments of Heaven, a fruitful source of sectional jealousy, perpetually tending to discord and disunion; a constant and increasing source of danger, which threatens every hour to involve us in a contest in which the Almighty has no attributes which could take sides with us, Do solemnly and importunately petition and implore your Honorable bodies, to take all measures within the scope of your constitutional powers, for the abatement and removal of this great evil,—By immediately abolishing Slavery and the Slave Trade in the District of Columbia and Territories subject to the jurisdiction of Congress, by prohibiting the internal and coasting Slave Trade between the several States, and by taking effectual measures to prevent the exportation of Slaves from the United States and its territories to Texas, or the dominions of any foreign power.
