For the purpose of taking into consideration the Subject of building a new meeting house. Elder Warner Lake was called to the chair and Joseph Crane was present as clerk of said Society.

After some dilberation resolved that we make an effort to build a new meetinghouse. Resolved that we build a house Thirty Six by Forty Eight feet with a petition to separate a small room for an Entry and stoves from the Main body of the house.

Resolved that a committee of five be appointed to draw a plan of said house and circulate a subscription for the purpose of raising money to pay for said house.

Resolved that Humphry Hunt , Edwin Stillson, Johnathan Hagadorn, Joseph Crane and Owin D. Lake compose said committee

Resolved that the condition for the payment of the subscription be one third first of January next, one third when the house is enclosed and the remainder

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Shen the house is finished.

Resolved that this meeting adjourn -----

4. Resolved that the house be enclosed with clear stuff pine siding and that the panel work inside of the house be first quality of pine lumber and that the remainder to finish said house be second rate lumber with the exception of the linings to the place and roof boards which may be 3rd quality

5. Resolved that this meeting vote by ballot to elect a committee of three to superintend the building of said meetinghouse
6. Resolved that the trustees of this Society shall collect the subscription as it comes due and pay it over to the building committee
8. Resolved that Joseph Crane, Humphry Hunt and William Begole be said committee
9. Resolved that we build the house according to the plan annexed to the subscription and that the house be finished within one year from this date
10. Resolved that if the subscription and sale of the slips are not sufficient to defray the expense of building said house that the Society will make up such deficiency
11. Resolved that this meeting adjourn -----

The meeting of said Society was then adjourned to the third Saturday of March, 1841.

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At a meeting of the Trustees of this Society held on the first day of April 1840 O. D. Lake was chosen clerk of Trustees. The Trustees agreed to let E. Stilson have the seats No. 29 and 31 to pay the balance due him on a/c of building meeting house.

At an annual meeting of the first Baptist Society of Mt. Morris held on the 2nd day of April, 1841 according to previous notice Dea. C. Stilson was chosen chairman and O. D. Lake being present as clerk.

The meeting adjourned to the third Saturday of March, 1842.

At a meeting of the first Baptist Society of the town of Mount Morris held at their meetinghouse according to a resolution of the church and previous public notice. Rev. H. G. Mosher was chosen Chairman, Orrin D. Lake present as clerk

The following resolutions were -----

Resolved . that it is expedient to sell the House and lot belonging to the Society when the sum of several hundred dollars can be obtained for the same.

Resolved. That when said property is sold eighty dollars be paid to Edwin Stilson for a debt of that amount which balance was due to him for building said house.

Resolved that the proceeds of the sale after paying said Stilson and necessary expenses be refunded to the original

Contributors for the building and purchase of said house and lot or to the owners of the interest of said contributors or to the heirs, executors or assignes of said contributors or owners.

And the sum so refunded shall bear the same proportion to the original contributions as the proceeds of the sale after deducting the said \$80 and necessary expenses shall bear to the original cost of said house and lot.

Resolved that should any balance remain in the hands of the society unclaimed by those entitled them for the term of two years from the time the same shall have been received, then the same shall be paid to the American and foreign Bible Society for the use and benefit of said Society.

Resolved. That a committee consisting of Thomas Wisner, Edwin Stilson and O. D. Lake

At the annual meeting of the first Baptist Society of Mt. Morris held at their meetinghouse on the 17 day of March 1849 according to previous notice. Rev. H. G. Mosher was appointed Chairman, O. D. Lake present as clerk.

John S. Wright and Edwin Stilson were elected as trustees of the first class. Victor Wright tendered his resignation as trustee of the first class, which was accepted and Lewis G. Ferris was elected to fill his vacancy. Adjourned to the Saturday before the third Sabbath March 1850 at 4 O'clock P. M.

June 14th Cov. Meeting after the usual services of cov. Meeting closed Church organized for the transaction of business

Voted to drop the following named persons from our fellowship - Eleanor Smock, Catharine Vandbeek, Sally McAllister, Selinda Herrick, Julia Miller, Emma Borden, Wm. Devinna 2nd, Jane Kilpatrick

Voted to give letters of dismissal to Angeline Begole and to Henry D. Hunt and wife

Voted that Father Lake and Brethern Isaac Fargo Jr., Edwin Stilson and O. D. Lake be our delegates to the association.

Voted that we call a council on the 2nd day of July next a 10 o'clock for the purpose

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Of taking into consideration to property of Setting apart Br. J. Fargo by ordination to the work of the Gospel Ministry

And that we request the following churches send delegates to sit with us in said council, viz the churches of Nunda, Castile, Sparta, Mt. Morris village, from Leicester, York and Avon Springs

Appointed Father Lake and Br. J. L. Wright a committee to present the business to the council

July 2, 1845 The above request was complied by all the churches except Castile and the churches represented together with visiting Brethern organized themselves in council by appointing O. D. Taylor Moderator and H. Bowen Clerk

After hearing the Christian experience call to the ministry and Doctrine view of Brother Isaac Fargo Jr.

The council proceeded to set him apart by solemn ordination to the works of the Gospel Ministry.

July 19 Cov. Meeting but few attended but seemed determined to maintain the interest of the cause here.

After close of covenant meeting church voted to raise by an average on the property of the church the balance of about \$40 to pay the arrearage still due to Elders Bowen and Fargo and that J. L. Wright, E. Stilson and O. D. Lake be a committee to average the same.

Voted to give Brother Fargo Jr. a letter setting forth his standing with us as a minister of the Gospel – he deeming it his duty cease his labors for the present on account of his health

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The committee formerly appointed to labor with Jno. Heliker reported that in their labors with him he manifested an obstinate and unchristian spirit. And it appearing to the satisfaction of the church that he had been guilty of immoderate drinking of ardent spirits and of racing horses it was Resolved that he excluded from the fellowship of the church.

Sept. 20th Covenant meeting good number present, good state of feeling. At the request of Br. Jas. V. Depuy voted to give letters of dismissal to himself and wife and Sister Jane Watson

Sunday, Sept. 21 The Sacrament administered by Father Lake and voted to give letters of dismissal to Br. H. M. Danil and wife.

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Feb. 14, 1846 – Covenant Meeting

Voted to give letters of dismission to Dea. Herrick and family who are members.

March 14 – Covenant meeting but few attended good state of feeling

Sunday 15 The Sacrament administered by Br. Fargo.

Sunday May 10. Preaching by Br. H. G. Moshier

May 17 Br. Moshier preached again. Church met and after consultation appointed a committee to circulate a subscription.

May 24 The committee reported to Br. Moshier the amount obtained on the subscription upon which he agreed to stay with us one year and serve us as pastor.

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Saturday June 20th – Covenant meeting but few present but a good state of feeling manifested and some renewed encouragement to persevrance

Voted to receive the following persons upon their letters of recommendation viz Eld. H. G. Moshier and his wife Phebe Moshier. Calvin Swift and wife, John Yeo and wife and Samuel M. Benedict

Voted to represent ourselves in the Livingston Association to be held at York on the 25th inst by the following Brethren as Delegates. Elders Moshier and Lake, Brethern Thos. Wisner, E. Stilson, J. S. Wright and O. D. Lake

Sunday 21 Eld. Moshier preacher our discourse and administered the Sacrament.
