Constitution

Article I Name

This organization shall be known as the Epworth League of the M. E. Church of Mt. Morris, and shall be subordinate to the Quarterly Conference of said Church and a chapter of the Epworth League of the M. E. Church.

Article II Object

The object of the League is to promote intelligent and loyal piety in the young members and friends of the Church, to aid them in the attainment of purity of heart and in constant growth in grace, and to train them in works of mercy and help.

Article III Membership

Members shall be constituted by election of the chapter, on nom. of the Pres. after approval by the Cabinet. The pastor shall be a member of the cabinet.

Article IV Departments

2. Mercy and Help
3. Literary
4. Social
5. Correspondence
6. Finance

Article V **Officers**

The officers shall be a President, Four Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer (Chorister, Two Organists, Collector)

The President who shall be a member of the M. E. Church shall be elected by ballot on a majority vote – The other officers who shall be members of the M. E. church or some other Evangelical Church, shall be elected in the same manner. The President must be approved by the Quarterly Conference or the Official Board.

Article VI

The Chapter shall hold a devotional meeting on Sunday evening of each week and other meetings as may be arranged by the members of the League.

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A regular semi-annual meeting of the Mt. Morris Epworth League was held in the classroom of the church Oct. 5th 1892. Meeting called to order by the president, Dr. Wm. Porall. Mrs. T. R. Austin acted as Secretary ProTem. Motion made and carried we rent a seat this year, the same as last. Motion made and carried the list of names be revised and each member pay five cents a month, to be paid on the first Sunday of every month commencing with Nov.
