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The following pages are copied from an old record book loaned to me by Reid Robinson of Springwater, New York. They were partly written in German, partly in English. Mr. and Mrs. Carl Brohm of Wayland translated the German for me. This book is a record of the German Lutheran Church of Sparta in the 1800's. I have not copied everything in order as in the book, but have grouped together the Baptisms, etc. for easier reference.

Sparta Livingston County, New York

In the year of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ 1837 June 1.
To the Honor of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost we the undersigned erect and build this church. We pray that the almighty and merciful Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, and also the Father of us all, bless this our humble work and that his holy Word in this His House bring honor and glory to His name and blessings to our immortal souls. This church shall be named St. Paul's Church. The following are the by-laws of this church.

- #1. This church is to be used only by the German Evangelical Lutheran and German Evangelical Reformed Congregations.
- #2. No other minister shall be allowed to preach in this church.
- #3. No minister, who makes it his business to preach at night and hold open meetings shall be allowed to preach in this church nor be our preacher.
- #4. No service can be held in this church at night.
- #5. The minister of our congregation has to preach in German once every 14 days.
- #6. No minister of the Evangelical Lutheran Hartwick Synode of this State shall ever set foot in the chancel of this church, nor ever be engaged as a minister.
- #7. Every member of this congregation shall sign his name in the church book and be subject to these by-laws. If his or her name is not signed they are not considered members.
- #8. Should a person, who is not a member, request to have a member of his family buried in our cemetery, so shall he pay first One dollar to the Church Treasury.
- #9. The leaders of this congregation shall consist of 2 Elders, 2 Trustees, and one President and be called the Council of Administration.
- #10. Should the majority of this congregation like to have a service in English, so can it be only done by our own minister and should not interfere with the German Service.
- #11. Should the now United Congregation of the German Evangelical Lutheran and the German Reformed Congregations desire to split and each have their own minister, then each minister is to preach in German once every 4 weeks and each congregation shall own half of this church.
- #12. In the event, these ministers should be absent and one of the members dies, another minister of a Christian Denomination can hold Service in this church, but not a minister of the Evangelical Lutheran Hartwick Synode of this State.

A copy of these By-laws, signed by each member is to be put in the cornerstone of this church.

(This church stood to the south of the old Dutch Cemetery in Sparta. Later it was moved to the Kiehle farm farther south and used for a barn. It was still there in 1963 but in poor repair)

Rules for our St. Paul's Congregation

God is above everything, a God of Order therefore it is our desire that our church life be clean Christians and above all good for our own souls.

General Rules. A.

1. The voting members of this congregation shall meet every first Saturday of the year to elect new officers and trustees.
2. To every such meeting shall be a Chairman and recording secretary elected by majority of votes.
3. Only male members are allowed to vote. Half of the officers to be voted on, on the first meeting, the other half the following year, so that in the future each officer serves two years. The outgoing officers can be reelected.
4. A Treasurer should also be elected. One officer can hold more than one office in the Church.
5. Every 3 months after the church service, the by-laws of the church shall be read, also each installation of Office and each officer shall receive in writing the duties of said office.
6. Confirmation classes, also Funeral services and Baptismal Services of non-members to be paid to the minister. Poor People are to be excluded.
7. The above mentioned yearly meeting shall be announced 4 weeks in advance.

Rules B.

1. The Council shall consist of 2 elders, 2 stewards and a president.
2. Only, morally clean men can hold such an Office.
3. The elders and the President are to see that the members of the congregation lead a good clean life.
4. The elders are to report to the minister of any sick member and to visit such with him.
5. It is also the duty of the elders to keep a watchful eye on the indifferent the ones that go astray and sin, to admonish them in Love and Sincerity, should this be fruitless, the President shall ask them before the Church Council and in the presents of the minister, should ask this also be ignored by said Person, he shall be brought before the whole congregation and such Person be expelled from the church.
6. All grievances and special happenings should be brought before the president who also has the right to vote.
7. The Stewards are to watch during the service against disturbances, take up collections, count and record them and hand the moneys to the Treasurer, also help the minister with Baptismals and light candles for services.
8. The church council together with the minister are to see that the youth of the church is properly instructed in the Gospel, have Sunday School, Choir practice and Confirmation instruction.
9. The church council is expected to be present at several sessions at the end of confirmation instructions.
10. The church council should meet every 3 months after service with the minister and discuss the good and bad of the congregation with him.
All such discussions are strictly confidential.
11. If the minister should leave, the council should look around for a new minister, who should then be elected by the congregation, by majority vote. In the event the new minister has not sufficient references, he can only be hired for 6 months in which time the council can examine the character of its new minister.
12. The church council, together with the treasurer are required to give a report at the annual congregational meeting, of all the finances taken in and paid out during the year.

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Rules C

Concerning the members.

1. A member is a person who was taken in to the church by confirmation and whose name is recorded in the church book.
2. Should an older person, who was not confirmed, like to become a member and unable to take instruction, he shall appear before the counsel and minister to be questioned, if he answers to their satisfaction, he can then become a member.
3. A person who was a member of another German Reformed or German Lutheran church, wishes to become a member of this church, should contact the President of the church counsel. He will bring the request before the congregation, and after a 6 months period be voted upon, to be admitted or rejected.
4. A woman who is a member of this church, and her husband a member of another church, or don't belong to any church, shall have the same rights as any other woman member, but can't have her children baptised without the request and presence of her husband.
5. All members are to abide by the decisions of the church counsel and have to appear before them if called, if not satisfied, such person can appeal to the whole congregation.
6. Every member should live a good clean Christian life to bring Honor to his church and himself, also to his soul. Every man has a duty to do his part for the salary of the minister and expenses of the church.
7. Any person who wishes to join the church, shall come before the counsel and minister, they can reject or recommend same to the congregation for membership.
8. Every member commits himself by writing his name in the church book, to abide by these rules. Those who cannot write their names will ask the minister to write their name in the presence of one or more counsel members, one of which must sign as a witness.
9. Should a member want to leave the church, he is to contact the President, who in turn brings it before the counsel and the congregation. If such members request a letter they shall have one signed by the members of the Church Counsel.
10. Should a none member request the service of our minister for a Funeral, it will be up to the minister to say yes or no. He can also make his own price.
11. All these bylaws and rules can be changed, dropped or others added, through majority vote of the congregation, but have to be 8 weeks ahead of time announced.

In special cases the president can call a meeting of the congregation.

Minutes of the St. Pauls Lutheran and Reformed Church East Mill
Sparta N.Y. Feb. 7, 1863

A meeting of the members of the consistory of St. Paul's Church was called at 2 o'clock at the church, in order to make arrangements to comply with the Synod, and ratified by the various classes of the German Reformed church respecting the celebration of the Tercentenary of the Meideleberg Catechism. The members of the consistory not being present it was agreed upon to meet at the home of Mrs C. Clayton at the Pastor's study on the evening of the 10th Tuesday.

Sparta Feb. 10, 1863

A meeting of the members of the consistory met at the study of the pastor. In compliance with synod and the New York classes of the German Reformed church, a list of the names of the members was made out in two columns, one with the names of the confirmed, the other the names of the unconfirmed. The list embraces also the names of persons who were connected with a similar organization in the town of Dansvill and have not actually united themselves with other Christian denominations. It was thought best to visit the members in order to solicit their free will offerings which was left in the hands of the Pastor.


