If you are a Veteran, you are eligible for extra credits added to your exam score if you pass. These extra credits can be used only once for any permanent government employment in New York State. If you want to have these extra credits added to your exam score, you must answer the questions now, and submit proof of eligibility (DD214 Member 4). You can waive the extra credits later if you wish.

If you are a Disabled Veteran, you are eligible for extra credits added to your exam score if you pass. These extra credits can be used only once for any permanent government employment in New York State. If you want to have these extra credits added to your exam score, you must answer the questions now, and submit proof of eligibility (DD214 Member 4). Please submit a Veterans Disability Records Release form (VC-4) to a Veteran's Affairs office or the Livingston County Veterans Services Agency. The completed VC-4 must be forwarded to our office within 30 days of the exam date. You can waive the extra credits later if you wish. If you already used your Veteran credit for permanent appointment or promotion and were subsequently classified by the Veterans Administration as disabled during time of war, you are entitled to use the additional Disabled Veteran credits.

If you are currently in the Armed Forces on full-time active duty (other than for training), you are also eligible for these extra credits after you are discharged and provide your DD214 Member 4 within 30 days of the exam date. If you want to have these extra credits added to your exam score, you must answer the questions now. You can waive the extra credits later if you wish.
