Priority

Oral Health Care

Objective

Increase the % of Medicaid enrollees with at least 1 preventive dental visit within the last year

Interventions

Collaborate with and train health care professionals on oral health promotion, early detection of oral diseases, and fluoride varnish application by 12/31/2030

Expand access to affordable dental care by conducting a RAM event to assist residents in obtaining dental care by 10/4/2028

Develop page dedicated to oral health on DOH websites which provides education by 6/30/2028
